Thank you so much for supporting your child with all of their school work over the last year, I am sure they are looking forward to a well-earned break over the summer. Pupils have worked incredibly hard over the past year and have done so whilst showing respect, kindness and consideration for others.

As pupils progress into the next academic year and begin their Key Stage 4 studies, you will notice a few changes to the way that teaching classes for subjects are grouped together. This means that pupils will be in sets for the following subjects:

Sets in Year 10

- Maths
- English Language/English Literature
- Combined Sciences
- RE
- Core PE

For option subjects, including triple science, pupils will mostly be in mixed-ability groups.

- The only exception to this is option subjects where there are multiple classes of the same subject in the same option block.
- This is the case for some History, Geography and MFL classes.
- Where there are multiple classes for these option subjects in the same option block, pupils will also be in sets.

Pupils will be informed of their new teaching groups when they return to school at the start of the new academic year.

Finally, can I thank you for your efforts in supporting your child to 'Read for Pleasure' and ensuring that they always have a reading book with them in school. I hope that they will take advantage of the summer break to invest some time spent reading.
