**Update on Examination Results, Summer 2023
Year 11 & Year 13**

Dear Families,

I wanted to take this opportunity to say congratulations on the hard work and resilience shown by Year 11 and Year 13 pupils during their examinations. We have been so impressed with all of the young people who have been sitting their external exams and very proud of their revision and preparation.

I would also like to remind you about how results arrangements will work in the coming weeks.

Arrangements for Results Days

- Key Stage 5 results will be available to Y13 students from the Sixth Form Centre [accessed via the rear of the school - across the metal bridge in the back car park] after **0830 on Thursday 17th August 2023.**
- Key Stage 4 results will be available to Y11 students from the Sixth Form Centre from **0900 on Thursday 24th August 2023.**
- Please note that results cannot be given out over the telephone or via e-mail.
- If students wish to have results posted, a 1st class, stamped addressed envelope [marked GCSE Year 11 in the top left hand corner] needs to be handed into the school office for the attention of Mrs Richardson [Examination Officer] no later than **Monday 17th July 2023.**

Exam Result Support

- Staff will be available on the results days to support students if they have any concerns about their results. This could include:
 - Advice around grade boundaries,
 - Guidance around reviews of results and appeals,
 - Support with next steps including careers guidance,
 - Support with UCAS and 6th form entry as appropriate.

- It is important that pupils complete the candidate section and ATS candidate consent section indicating whether or not you would be happy for our centre to access your scripts, and if so, whether you wish for your name to be removed.

Please bring the completed form with you on results day and hand it into staff as you collect your results.
