## Sixth Form Enrolment Process

Dear Families,

As Year 11 approaches the end of their external examinations I'd firstly like to take this opportunity to congratulate them on their conduct, hard work and resilience. As your child considers their next steps, I'd like to take this opportunity to outline the Sixth Form enrolment process once more.

### 1. Sixth Form Induction Day: Wednesday 3rd July

- All students who are planning to return to Sixth Form to continue their studies are invited back into school on Wednesday 3rd July 2024 [in the Sixth Form Centre] to continue their preparations for entry into Year 12.
- The aim of this day is to bridge the gap between Year 11 and 12 study and give a greater understanding of the expectations of a Sixth Form student and allow them to make informed subject choices for this September.
- We will cover aspects of life in the Sixth Form. This will include opportunities to attend Sixth Form lessons, experience independent study periods and hear from current students.
- All students are expected to attend this induction event if they plan to return [or are considering returning]. If a student is unable to attend, then please contact Mrs Brown via the Sixth Form email address provided at the end of this letter.
- Students are expected to attend in full school uniform.

### 2. GCSE Results Day: Thursday 22nd August

- Results will be available from the Sixth Form Centre [accessed via the rear of the school - across the metal bridge in the back car park] after 0900 on Thursday 22nd August 2024.
- Please note that results cannot be given out over the telephone or via e-mail.
- If students wish to have results posted, a 1st class, stamped addressed envelope [marked GCSE Year 11 in the top left-hand corner] needs to be given to Mrs Richardson [Examination Officer] no later than Monday 15th July 2024.
- If there are any exceptional circumstances where a pupil is unable to collect their results in person, and they have not provided a stamped addressed envelope in advance, please inform the school via the House emails as soon as possible.



### 3. Registration for Sixth Form Courses: Thursday 22nd August & Friday 23rd August

- If you have met all of the entry requirements for your desired courses of study, you should register for the Sixth Form on results day [Thursday 22nd August 2024]. This should be done using a Google Form that will be shared on the day. This form will be available on the school website.
- Students should consult the Sixth Form Prospectus on the website to ensure that they have met the entry requirements and that their preferred subjects fit within our option blocks. Please note that all subject options are subject to change.
- If your child is unsure about which subjects to choose or misses out on meeting the entry requirements, they should make an appointment with the Sixth Form team. These meetings will take place on **Friday 23rd August 2024** in the Sixth Form Centre. Appointments can be arranged on results day.
- If your child is unable to attend then please contact Mrs Brown via the Sixth Form email address provided at the end of this letter.
