Dear Families,

It has been wonderful to see the positive start that Year 10 pupils have made to their GCSE and vocational studies this academic year. I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for everything you do to support your child at home to help make their Key Stage 4 learning journey as successful as possible.

I am writing to inform you about the forthcoming assessments for all Year 10 pupils, which will begin the week commencing **Monday, January 13, 2025**. These assessments provide pupils with an excellent opportunity to demonstrate and apply their learning in their various courses and to practise sitting exam-style papers at this relatively early stage in their Key Stage 4 studies. They also serve as a valuable rehearsal for the end-of-year assessments in the summer term and will help pupils to begin their revision preparations.

All pupils will receive a revision advice guide, which includes strategies to support them in planning and managing their revision. This guide will also include specific revision material for Maths and English preparation work in the lead-up to the assessments. While it is important for students to enjoy a rest over the Christmas holidays, we encourage them to allocate some time for revision to ensure they are well-prepared when they return in January.

During the assessment period:

- Examinations will take place during normal lessons.
- All pupils are expected to have full attendance and arrive at school punctually.
- Pupils should come fully prepared for their assessments and demonstrate formal behavior, ready to perform to the best of their ability.
- Revision materials and a revision planner will be provided to help pupils manage their time effectively and prepare thoroughly for the examinations.
