End of Year Examinations - Summer 2025

Dear Families,

This week in assemblies we are launching our **Raising Achievement Plan** with students. In the six weeks prior to every formal examination period, we will provide your child with the tools and support they need to do their very best in the end of year examinations. This same routine will be followed before every end of year assessment as students progress through the school, in order to help them build the essential independent revision skills needed for success.

The end of year examinations will begin on the 2nd June. Individual teachers will inform students of the date and time of the examinations for each of their subjects. These examinations will take place in their usual classrooms, under examination conditions.

The end of year examinations are a key opportunity for students to develop their revision skills and organisation, to secure their learning over the past year, and to review their progress to date ahead of commencing their GCSE courses next academic year. As such, it is vital that students undertake a programme of revision in order to sufficiently prepare for the examinations.

Students have been given a revision booklet which outlines how they should prepare for the end of year examinations and strategies for how they can most effectively revise.
