Year 11 Mock Examinations

Dear Families,

It has been wonderful to see how well our Year 11 students have done during the first part of our Raising Achievement Plan, in the build up to their first mock examinations of the school year. The examinations will begin immediately after the half-term break on **Monday 3rd November 2025**.

These examinations will be a very important opportunity for our Year 11 students to demonstrate their current progress and to identify the areas where they need to develop. It is also a chance to sit an exam in a formal environment and offers a good rehearsal for the final examinations next summer.

Throughout this programme of examinations:

- All students are expected to have full attendance and to be punctual to school each day.
- When not in examinations, students will be in their normal lessons.
- All examinations start at either 0900 or 1300. Year 11 students will be permitted to go in for first dinners if they have an exam, but they need to be ready for a prompt start.
- Students should ensure that they are ready, in their pastoral rooms, before the exam start time. Students will be collected class by class and taken to the examination rooms to help ensure a calm and orderly start.
- Students should have the correct equipment: 2x **black** pens, approved calculator (for relevant exams/papers), appropriate apparatus: ruler, protractor, etc. (for relevant exams/papers) and if desired: a clear pencil case, clear water bottle (with label removed). A list of unauthorised items can be found on the school website in the 'Exam Information for Students' section.
- Students are not permitted to have **any** type of watch in the examination hall. Also, they are not allowed a mobile phone or any other web-enabled device. Highlighters may be used on the questions *only* and not within written answers.
- Students can only leave the examination room when necessary and they must be accompanied by an invigilator. Students should be going to the toilet before they enter the exam room.



- Students will be issued with a personal examination timetable. The overall mock timetable can be found below for your reference.
- Students have been provided with RAP (Raising Achievement Plan) revision materials for each of their subjects to help them manage their time and to prepare effectively for these examinations.
- The timetabled subject support sessions will pause at the end of this half-term for the start of the examinations and begin again for our next Raising Achievement Plan cycle in December.

Arrangements for the mock examinations will be shared with all Year 11 students in an assembly.

Results of the mock examinations will be shared formally with students as part of a Celebration Assembly next half term and will be shared with parents and carers through Arbor.

The Master Classes that have been facilitated by the English and Mathematics departments in the lead-up to the exams each week will continue to run up into the final week of this half-term. These classes are planned to give advice on exam technique and performance and to build confidence before the mock examinations. We very much appreciate your cooperation in encouraging your child to attend these valuable Master Classes.

Please note that students who already attend subject support on these days must continue to prioritise these sessions.
