This week in assembly, we launched our Raising Achievement Plan (RAP) with Year 12 students. RAP runs for six weeks before each major assessment period, providing structured support to help students develop independent revision habits essential for success in the Sixth Form and beyond.

The Module 1 assessments will take place during the week commencing **Monday 12th January 2026**.

As this is Year 12's first formal assessment in their new courses, it's a vital opportunity for students to reflect on their progress in advance of the end-of-year mock exams in the summer. All assessments will be held in classrooms under exam conditions, and teachers will confirm with the students when their subject assessments will take place ahead of time.
